

Event: Tail of the Lake

Date: Sunday, October 4, 2015

Who: Varsity and Novice Rowers and coxswains.

Launch Site: Seattle Rowing Center: 1116 W Ewing St Seattle, WA 98119 (Different from Row for the Cure).

Arrival Time: Athletes should arrive at Seattle Rowing Center at 5:45 AM.

Parking and Athlete Drop Off:

Only trailers and immediate support vehicles will be allowed inside the chain link fence.

Athletes can be dropped off at the Chain Link fence entry to our property and walk in.

There is a great deal of additional parking available on W Ewing Street to the west of us (accessed off 13th West) and West Ewing Street to the east of us (accessed off 11th West).

Coaches / Coxswain meeting: 6AM at Gasworks Park. Coxswains should allow 5-10 minutes to get from their cars to the meeting location overlooking Lake Union. At the conclusion of the meeting, coxswains should head directly to Seattle Rowing Center.

Race Format: 3 flights (7:30, 9:30 and 11:15)

Head Racing: Boats line up in numerical order by event and race "against the clock." Times are then sorted, determining winners. There is limited passing of boats during racing.

Launch Time: Crews should expect to launch 45 minutes prior to their race time. Race times are approximate.

Course: 4,000 Meter Race. Start at the gas dock along Westlake Ave, southeast of the Aurora Bridge. Row a scenic loop around the south end of Lake Union, completing the circumnavigation of Lake Union by crossing the finish line off Gasworks Park.

Viewing: Limited viewing from the Fremont Bridge. Good views of the entire race, and the finish line, from Gasworks Park. Viewing of the staging area from the Fremont Ship Canal.

- The Coach/Cox/Bow meeting will still be held at 6:00 a.m. at Gasworks Park, at which time the decision to delay in half hour increments or cancel will be made.
